

*Benefits of Giving Through the  
First Baptist Church of Round Rock  
Foundation:*

- **EVERY** gift is an investment in what God is doing through the ministries of First Baptist Church.
- Gifts of **CASH** may qualify for an income tax charitable deduction.
- Gifts of **LONG-TERM APPRECIATED ASSETS**, such as real estate or stock, may avoid capital gains tax on the sale by the Foundation and may qualify for an income tax charitable deduction.
- Gifts to **LIFE-INCOME TRUSTS** may qualify for an income tax deduction and reduce estate taxes.
- **BEQUESTS** through a will or living trust may reduce estate taxes.
- Naming the Foundation as beneficiary of tax-deferred investments, such as an **IRA, Retirement Plan, Annuity or Life Insurance**, avoid probate and may qualify for income tax and estate tax deductions.
- **P.O.D.** (Payable on Death) **Accounts** naming the Foundation as the designated beneficiary, such as checking or savings accounts, avoid probate and may reduce estate taxes.

The Foundation qualifies as a tax-exempt organization under 501 ( c ) ( 3 ) with the Internal Revenue Service. Gifts to the Foundation may be tax deductible. Articles of Incorporations and Financial Statement are available on request.

## *Why a Foundation?*

Over the years, many of our members have made special gifts to the First Baptist Church above and beyond regular budget contributions. Some gifts have been in memory or honor of a loved one. Others have been bequests in wills. Even non-members have made special gifts.

The Foundation was established to facilitate such special gifts and to provide for their appropriate use.

Through gifts to the Foundation, church members and non-members can be assured that their gifts are making a significant and lasting contribution to the work of the Lord through The First Baptist Church of Round Rock, Texas.

## *What is a Foundation ?*

The Foundation is a separate non-profit corporation recognized by the IRS as a qualified supporting organization of The First Baptist Church of Round Rock, Texas. Contributions to the Foundation may be tax-deductible.

## *How Does the Foundation Operate?*

The Foundation has a Board of Trustees and operates under clearly established guidelines as to the investment of funds and the making of grants.

## *Designation of Gifts & Bequests*

The Foundation receives Gifts and Bequests of any amount. Gifts and Bequests should be designated as either readily available for use or an endowment.

The Foundation board encourages undesignated Gifts and Bequests to allow flexibility in using the funds for the greatest needs. However, for those who wish to designate their Gifts and Bequests, the following designated funds have been established: Mission Funds, Building Maintenance Fund, New Facilities Fund, and Scholarship Fund.

## *How to Make a Gift?*

To make Gifts to the Foundation, please contact the Church Office at 255-3454. Your Gift, if you desire, can be made in memory or in honor of someone. The Foundation will honor requests that donors remain anonymous.

## *Making a Bequest in Your Will*

The Foundation may be named as a beneficiary in your will or living trust. Details are included in the Foundation Information Book available in the Church Office.

## *Grants*

Upon recommendation of the Board of Trustees, grants will be made in response to periodic applications submitted through church committees.

## *Reports*

The Board of Trustees submit a written Annual Report to the The First Baptist Church of Round Rock, Texas. Minutes of the meeting of the Board of Trustees, resolutions, and copies of the annual audit will be available in the Church Office.

## *Additional Information*

A Foundation Information Book will be available in the Church Office. It provides additional, detailed information such as the Charter, the By-Laws, the Supporting Organization Agreement, Gift Forms, Grant Forms, the Annual Report, and Information on Bequests.
